Notes to the Teacher

Can't fit in the full GO lesson? Incorporate this 5 minute mission moment into your club weekly, monthly or just during your Missions Month as a way to:

- **Teach** – so clubbers know what God is doing globally to reach kids. Show the *Asmita Lesson Video* available in the lesson portal. Share the Bible truth and verse.
- **Connect** – by sharing the testimony and ask the interactive questions below. Stress how God used Awana to reach and impact their lives.
- **Empower** – kids to support the Awana ministry, missionaries, kids attending Awana and kids yet to be reached in Nepal. Support can be done through prayer and/or financially. Your financial support helps kids attend Awana where they hear the gospel and are engaged in ongoing discipleship by trained caring adults.

Feel free to adapt and be creative in placing a spotlight on missions.

Asmita turned to Jesus to see if He was real, and He answered her prayers. Now, she has learned that even when things are difficult, she can trust God to be with her.

- Do you think it's easier or harder for people in another country to know God is always with them? Why?
- When have you been sure God was with you in a hard or scary time? How can you help others know He is always there?
