

Resurrection Sunday helps us remember God's special plan.

Jesus died to take the punishment for our sins, as God had promised He would. And because Jesus is alive, all people everywhere can have salvation and eternal life. When we believe that Jesus is God's Son and that He died for us, our sins are forgiven and we can be part of God's family!

Gather your family together and watch this special Easter Video.



Instructions to make your own Bible storybook:


1. Open and Print the <u>He's Alive</u> Coloring Book PDF file. When printing, use the "shrink oversized page" feature so the book will fit on 8 1/2 – 11 sheets of paper.



- 2. Cut each page in the middle along the black line.
- 3. Assemble the pages in order and staple the left side to form your own <u>He's Alive Coloring Book</u>.
- 4. Ask someone to read this very special book to you.
- 5. Enjoy coloring your new book about the Resurrection of Jesus.

Characters for Retelling

Instructions to make your own Characters for Retelling – He's Alive:

Open and Print the <u>He's Alive</u> Flannelgraph PDF file.
 You may choose the color or black and white file.
 When printing, use the "shrink oversized page" feature so the images will fit on 8 1/2 – 11 sheets of paper.





- 2. Color the characters if using the black and white file.
- 3. Ask an adult to help you cut out each character.
- 4. If you want your characters to stand up, glue a piece of cardboard to each page before you cut out the characters. Use play dough to make a stand for each characters. See the pictures below.
- 5. Cut out the additional pieces such as the cave, stone, and trees.
- 6. Ask an adult to read the account provided as you move the characters to retell the story of Jesus' Resurrection.

Your death was very sad, but it was the best gift You could have given us.


