Unit 3 Review – Redemption

SUMMARY

Unit 3 of *Trek 1* describes how God has a plan for the redemption of His people. Ever since Adam and Eve committed the first sin, humans were separated from God, and they were living under the consequences of that separation. But God's plan was to bring His people out from underneath the weight of that separation by forgiving their sin. He did this by showing that He had a rescuing intent with Noah and the flood that He wanted to make a great nation for Himself through Abraham, that He was a mighty deliverer for His people through Moses, and that He establishes an eternal kingdom through David. Ultimately, it was Jesus' historical death on the cross and His resurrection from the dead that paid for the sins of all who would trust Him. And all who do indeed trust Him are made a part of His eternal kingdom in heaven.
